INTRODUCTION

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Professor E. A. C. L. E. Schelpe was born in Durban on the 27th of July 1924. In 1943, he completed his B.Sc., with a distinction in Botany, at Natal University College. In 1946, he went on to complete a Class 1 M.Sc. there. In 1946, he completed his Ph.D. at Oxford University.

His professional life began as a Lecturer in Botany at UCT in 1953. In 1954, he was promoted to Senior Lecturer in Plant Taxonomy there and was made a curator of the Bolus Herbarium. In 1968, he was promoted to the Directorship of the Herbarium and made an Associate Professor. In 1973, he was made a full Professor.

He attended a number of Conferences on orchids and ferns, including in, Honolulu, London, Edinburgh and Bangkok. He was part of various Expeditions to Mount Kenya, the Ethiopian Highlands, Mozambique, the Himalayas, NW Thailand and Papua New Guinea. He was awarded the Gold Medal from The Orchid Society of SE Asia and the Gold Medal of The Orchid Society of South Africa as well as the Silver Medal from The Association of South African Botanists.

He was a member of the Linnean Society of London and The Royal Society of South Africa. He was President of the International Orchid Commission and of the Botanical Society of South Africa. He published numerous research documents from 1948 onwards as well as a number of books covering his special interest in Pteridophyta, Bryophyta and Orchidaceae.

THE COLLECTION

This collection, donated to the University of Cape Town Libraries, consists primarily of documents relating to the Pteridophyta (Ferns) and the Orchidaceae (Orchids) and to a far lesser extent Bryophyta (Mosses and Liverworts) and others. There are numerous extracts and reprints from foreign journals on these particular subjects.

There is very little that reflects the personal life of Professor Edward Schelpe. There is no personal correspondence and even his notebooks are taken up with data on Botanical subjects. What correspondence does exist is of a professional nature and reflects his work in his various fields within Botany and at the Bolus Herbarium.

There is little too, to reflect on his life as a Lecturer and Professor at UCT, with a few files on plant taxonomy, some correspondence and precious little else. Even his positions at the Bolus Herbarium are not particularly well represented here with archival documents.

The private man remains largely a mystery with one photograph of him at a visit to a mine. Nevertheless, there are ample detailed botanical documents for researchers.
